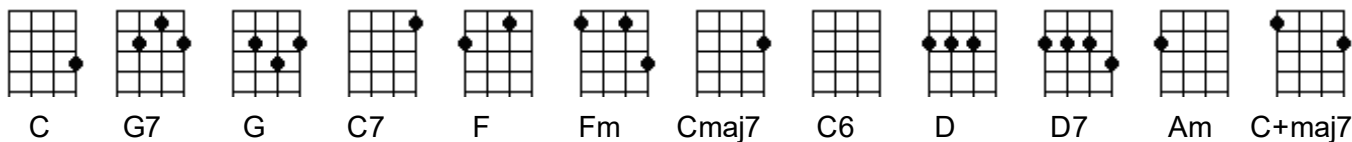


# Coffee by The Brass Traps

/Am /C+maj7 /C /Am

*Verse 3* /C G /C C7 /F Fm /C G  
(spoken:) I can't help but think about you, though my heart is wont to break  
/C Cmaj7 /C6 C /D D7 /G G7

... one for you, by mistake  
(sung:) And now,  
/Am /C+maj7 /C (stop) /Am (pause)  
the mug that you should be drinking is just one of *three* mugs in a row:
